Eighty Five teachers got their research papers published in reputed National and International Journals. Dr. Harbir Singh Randhawa edited a book 'Dalit Literature : Contents, Trends and Concerns' in 2010 published by Sarup Publishers, New Delhi with ISBN. Dr. Anju Bali Pandey, Associate Professor of the department of History wrote a book entitled 'History of Christian Missionary Schools in Doon Valley'. She is the first Indian to have worked on Tunisia, a North African Country and earlier she wrote a book entitled 'Father of Tunisia – Habib Bourgimba' which was released by the Ambassador of Tunisia in India.

Two National Seminars were organized in this year. One Seminar with the topic 'Gender and Development' was organized by the dept. of Political Science as per the financial support of U.G.C. Another seminar was organized by the department of Zoology, on the topic 'Recent Advances in Parasitological Research' sponsored by U.G.C., CSIR, ICMR, UCOST and DRDO.

Career Counselling and Placement cell of the college conducted 'job melas' by inviting multinational companies and more than 90 students got decent job offers from IBM Daksh, Keane and Cipla.

NSS Units of the college organised ten days camps in different adopted villages and 44 campers donated blood in Blood Donation Camp. Red Ribbon club conducted Essay competition on HIV/AIDS besides slogan and poster competitions for disseminating the dangers of AIDS among the society through the volunteers. They also conducted environmental awareness rallies and social upliftment endeavours for the betterment of the society.
