## Student Performance and Learning Outcomes

(Academic Year 2023-2024)

### Program-wise and Gender-wise Analysis

The student performance data for the academic year 2023-2024 provides insights into the success rates of undergraduate and postgraduate programs. The data highlights variations in pass percentages, gender distribution, and the number of students scoring CGPA 6 or above.

#### Undergraduate Programs

- **Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)**

A total of 1,051 students appeared for the final year examinations, out of which 709 successfully passed, resulting in a pass percentage of 67.46%. Among the 561 female students, 423 passed, indicating a strong female success rate. 330 students achieved a CGPA of 6 or above, with 234 being female.

- **Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.)**

The program saw 968 students appearing for the final exams, with 790 clearing them, yielding a pass percentage of 81.61%. Among the 488 female students, 424 passed. A total of 362 students scored above CGPA 6, including 234 females.

- **Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)**


Out of 750 students, 486 passed, giving a pass percentage of 64.80%. The program had 324 female students, with 232 successfully passing. A total of 322 students secured a CGPA of 6 or above, including 173 females.

#### Professional Programs

- **Bachelor of Law (LL.B.)**

A total of 217 students appeared for the exams, with 138 passing, resulting in a pass percentage of 63.59%. Among them, 91 were female, with 62 passing. 72 students achieved a CGPA of 6 or above, with 47 being female.

Out of 34 students, 33 cleared their final exams, recording a pass percentage of 97.05%. The class had 16 female students, all of whom passed. A total of 16 students achieved CGPA 6 or higher, all of whom were female.

### Postgraduate Programs

- **Master of Arts (M.A.) in Sociology**

Out of 99 students, 91 passed, yielding a pass percentage of 91.91%. The program had 64 female students, of which 60 passed. 63 students achieved a CGPA of 6 or above, including 43 females.

- **Master of Arts (M.A.) in History**

A total of 42 students took the exams, and 38 passed, leading to a pass percentage of 90.47%. The program had 25 female students, with 22 passing. 33 students scored CGPA 6 or above, with 20 females among them.

- **Master of Arts (M.A.) in English**

The program had 55 students, with 54 passing, reflecting a pass percentage of 98.18%. 50 of these students were female, of whom 49 passed. A total of 49 students scored a CGPA of 6 or higher, including 44 females.

- **Master of Arts (M.A.) in Geography**

Out of 18 students, 17 passed, with a pass percentage of 94.44%. The class had 11 female students, 10 of whom passed. 16 students achieved CGPA 6 or above, with 10 being female.

- **Master of Arts (M.A.) in Political Science**

A total of 85 students enrolled, with 78 passing, leading to a pass percentage of 91.76%. Among them, 52 were female, with 50 passing. 77 students scored a CGPA of 6 or above, with 50 being female.

- **Master of Arts (M.A.) in Economics**

Out of 92 students, 64 successfully cleared the exams, reflecting a pass percentage of 69.56%. 58 students were female, with 41 passing. 58 students attained CGPA 6 or above, of which 39 were female.

- **Master of Arts (M.A.) in Education**

A total of 4 students were enrolled, and all 4 passed, making it a 100% pass percentage. All students were female, and all secured a CGPA of 6 or above.

- **Master of Arts (M.A.) in Psychology**

The class had 16 students, with 14 passing, leading to a pass percentage of 87.5%. Among them, 11 were female, with 10 passing. 12 students secured a CGPA of 6 or above, including 9 females.

- **Master of Commerce (M.Com.)**

A total of 165 students appeared, out of which 136 passed, yielding a pass percentage of 82.42%. Among them, 117 were female, with 99 passing. 123 students achieved CGPA 6 or above, including 93 females.

- **Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Chemistry**

The program had 25 students, with 23 passing, resulting in a pass percentage of 92%. 18 were female, with 17 passing. All 23 students scored CGPA 6 or above, including 17 females.

- **Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Botany**

Out of 15 students, 14 passed, giving a pass percentage of 93.33%. The program had 13 female students, 12 of whom passed. All 14 students secured a CGPA of 6 or above, with 12 being female.

- **Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Zoology**

All 18 students passed the final exams, leading to a 100% pass percentage. Among them, 16 were female, all of whom passed. 18 students secured a CGPA of 6 or above, including 16 females.

- **Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Physics**

Out of 25 students, 22 passed, with a pass percentage of 88%. The program had 14 female students, 13 of whom passed. 22 students attained CGPA 6 or above, including 13 females.

- **Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Statistics**

The class of 20 students saw all 20 passing, resulting in a 100% pass percentage. Among them, 7 were female, all of whom passed. 17 students scored a CGPA of 6 or above, with 7 being female.

- **Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Mathematics**

The class had 60 students, with 40 passing, leading to a pass percentage of 66.66%. 28 of them were female, with 20 passing. 25 students secured a CGPA of 6 or above, including 13 females.

- **MA Mathematics**

With 3 students the class saw 1 student passing the exam with pass percentage of 33.33%. These 3 were females and only 1 female passed with the 6 CGPA mark.

- **MA Sanskrit**

Out of 8 students, 6 students passed the final year examinations, yielding a pass percentage of 75%. Out of 6 females 4 passed, with one yielding a pass percentage of 6 CGPA.

## Total pass students

Out of total 3,869 students that appeared for the examination 2,887 students passed making the pass percentage 73.26% for the session.

While some courses had a 100% pass percentage, the sample size of students is low in those subjects. While in some subjects with a higher student who appeared for final examinations the percentage has shown a great result which is not 100% but nearing to 80-90s.

### 1. Higher Pass Rates in Postgraduate Programs

- o Many postgraduate programs, such as M.A. in English, M.A. in Sociology, M.Sc. in Statistics, and M.A. in Education, achieved 100% pass percentages.
- o Undergraduate programs showed more variation, with B.Com. (81.61%) performing exceptionally well.

### 2. Consistent Female Performance

- o Across programs, female students demonstrated strong academic performance, often constituting the majority of those who passed and secured CGPA 6 or higher.
- o Notable programs with strong female success rates include M.A. in English, M.A. in Sociology, and B.Ed., where most female students passed with distinction.

### 3. CGPA 6+ Performance Trends

- o A significant proportion of students achieving CGPA 6 or above were female, particularly in arts and science streams.
- o Programs such as B.Com., M.Com., and B.A. had a large number of students securing CGPA 6 and above, indicating strong academic performance across disciplines.
